UNISON asked local government employers in England, Wales and Northern Ireland for a pay increase of  $\pounds3,000$  or 10%, whichever was greater. The offer we received falls short of this at  $\pounds1,290*$ .

Council and school workers go above and beyond every single day to provide the vital services that we all rely on. With the cost-of-living crisis continuing to hit working people the hardest, we're pushing for a decent pay rise for our members.

We are consulting members on this offer now and want you to have your say. We recommend that you vote to reject the offer.

\* If you work part time or term time only hours, the increase would be less depending on how many hours you work. The offer will be different for members in London; in outer London, the offer is  $\pounds1,491$  and in inner London it's  $\pounds1,575$ . The offer does little to address the continual erosion of pay that members have suffered over the past fourteen years. It's time to stand together for better pay.
