Wanted! Emergency funding to reverse this year's cuts

We have a new Labour Government with a huge majority in Parliament.

We call on the Labour controlled city council to demand that the new Government provides emergency funding for Nottingham to stop the cuts destroying our city.

The cuts below have already started and further cuts across almost 100 services - including closure of libraries and cuts in opening hours and closure of the two remaining elderly persons care homes - are proposed.

- Charges for use of public toilets.
- End of the Jackdawe service which is a specialist homecare service for citizens with complex care needs and unlikely to be catered for in the private sector
- Cuts to the council's customer services making it digital only access
- Closure of remaining youth provision and cuts to youth justice service

- £1.34 million cut to voluntary sector organisations providing much needed support service to many disadvantaged groups.
- Ending of funding to all lunch clubs which combatted loneliness for the elderly.
- Reduced funding to community centres which will end up having to close.
- Cut the Council's Welfare Rights service on top of cuts to advice centres.
- Cuts of £2.2 million to the Community Protection service.
- Cuts to the Cultural sector of £1.98 million.
